Notes on calendars

Enrolment Periods

- Enrolment periods are indicative. The date and time for registration must be consulted on the Intranet.

Cultural Week

- Class schedules will not be affected by the Cultural Week except for Campus Day, Thursday the 11th of May, in which there will be no classes.

Midterm, final and re-evaluation exam periods

- During the exam periods indicated in the academic calendar there will be no classes of any kind.
- Dates and times for each particular exam can be found in the exams calendar approved by the Permanent Commission.
- Any exam programmed to be hold outside the periods established in this calendar must be scheduled exclusively during the subject class hours.

Deadline for entering grades in PRISMA

- The dates set in the calendar have been determined as the maximum ones to allow carrying out other processes, such as curricular evaluations or TFE defence.
- In accordance with the ESEIAAT evaluation regulations and the deadline for entering grades in PRISMA, the maximum data of publishing grades in Atenea and for the exams revision is
 - o the 27th of January in fall semester
 - o the 27th of June in spring semester
 - o the 10th of July for re-evaluation exams

Odd or Even Week

- In the subjects' schedule published on the ESEIAAT Intranet, there are some classes that are planned in alternate weeks for different groups, marked as S. Senar (Odd Week) or S. Parell (Even Week). For each group organization, what is indicated in this calendar must be followed. In the SS/SP column of the academic calendar, you can identify the weeks that the SS groups and the SP groups have classes.
- The symbol "--" in this column indicates that there is no class in the time slot in which the groups alternate, neither for the SS groups nor the SP groups.
- In the spring semester, in the week from April 17 to 21, there is only class for SS groups on the 20th of April. The rest of the days there is no class in the time slots in which the groups alternate neither for the SS groups nor for the SP groups.

Recovery of missed classes

- It has only been possible to programme days of class recovery in the spring semester, on Tuesday, the 6th of June.
- Classes that could not be taught during the lecture period due to justified absence of the
 professor or to cancellation by the school may be recovered. Once the recovery is authorised, it is
 necessary to request the classroom and time scheduling in advance from academic
 management.
