On the final thesis website of the Terrassa School of Industrial, Aerospace and Audiovisual Engineering (ESEIAAT) you'll find all the information you need on the content and format of the files to be submitted.



Your supervisor will be responsible for approving your thesis for submission. They must review your thesis before you formally deposit it in Atenea TFE.
